#### **Collaborative Needs Assessment**

Conduct a collaborative needs assessment through facilitated meetings with district and/or school leaders. Assessment will include: identification of goals and priorities; school site visits; examination of student data and the impact of particular practices; and determination of needed supports.

#### **Data Strategy**

Analysis and technical assistance on the latest research and data to assess whether district or school systems and practices are supporting all students to succeed.

#### **District or School Professional Development**

Professional learning to examine the research and data on the key factors for student success. Teams will also explore effective and equitable practices for implementation.

#### **Equity-Based Leadership Workshop**

An intensive experience designed to push your thinking, provoke questions, prompt critical reflection, and collectively make deeper meaning of how equity work can be applied to your practice.

## **Leading Professional Learning Communities** Workshop

Training for staff leaders responsible for developing professional learning communities and implementing effective adult collaboration. Participants will gain strategies for leading equity-centered work among adults as well as practice in concrete tools and protocols.
